SUMMER ENROLLMENT: This summer OFMS will study THE FARM! If you plan for your child to attend OFMS this summer please make sure you have turned in your contract. <u>MANY CLASSROOMS ARE ALREADY FULL!</u> Remember students that attend OFMS during the regular 9 month school year DO NOT pay a summer R/S fee. We do offer a summer program for children that do not attend OFMS during the 9 month school year. This program serves students in Kindergarten through 5th Grade. Please see the office for details.

2015-2016 ENROLLMENT: Enrollment contracts for the 2015-2016 school year were due back February 27th. Enrollment for the general public began March 2nd. We have a number of students on the waiting list and have begun placing them in classrooms. <u>MANY CLASSROOMS ARE ALREADY FULL!</u> If you have not already done so please be sure and turn your contracts and fees in, we do not want you to lose your spot!
