Logo: Our logo is the two hands reaching into the sky for two oak leaves. We chose the oak leaves because they symbolize the materials, tools and guidance that Oak Forest Montessori School provides. The hands reaching symbolize the child's learning potential and how there is no limit to what he/she can do.

Mission Statement:

The Oak Forest Montessori School is consistent with the philosophy and mission of Dr. Maria Montessori and her work with children – to help each child reach their full potential in all areas of life.

Policy Spotlight

Why does Oak Forest Montessori School have a dress code and/or require uniforms? The Montessori classroom is a prepared environment. The materials, furniture, the minimal pictures and posters, the books and music have all been selected to create a space, which is conducive to concentration, higher level thinking and creative expression. The uniform clothing, worn by the children, then becomes part of the environment and does not become a distraction.

Why does it matter what kind of shoes my child wears to school?

Our main priority is the safety of your child. As you know, our students go out on the playground once a day if enrolled in the morning program and 2 or 3 times a day if enrolled in the full or extended day program. Tennis shoes are the safest option and allow the students to move about freely on the playground equipment. Wood chips cover all of the areas surrounding the playground equipment to provide a cushion in the event of a fall. Remember, little ones are constantly developing their gross motor skills! Tennis shoes allow for freedom of movement. If a child goes out on the playground wearing open toe shoes or cowboy boots, etc. he/she does not have that same freedom of movement and if wearing sandals, could easily get a splinter from the wood chips. Another priority that we mentioned above is providing an environment conducive to learning. Think about when you buy your child a new pair of shoes. Maybe they are light up or even one of their favorite Disney characters. Your child LOVES those shoes and they want everyone to know about them and how fast they make them run! Children are proud and want to show off the wonderful things their parents have provided for them. Circle time/line time and group lessons are provided each day. The students sit in a circle on their classroom rug in "criss cross applesause" style (their legs are crossed in front of them). This is a wonderful opportunity to show off those light up shoes and it often becomes a distraction to the learning process.

Parent-Teacher Conferences:

We will offer hearing and vision screening on campus October 15th for children that are in need and have not already had the screening. Keep an eye out for registration forms!

Uniforms:

Winter uniform order forms will be going out on Monday, October 6th. The forms may be used to order long sleeve shirts as well as the OFMS navy blue zip up hoodie. We will have a few on reserve but each year we sell out quickly! Remember you may purchase long sleeve polo uniforms OR your child may continue to wear their short sleeve polo with a solid long sleeve shirt underneath. The shirt worn underneath must be a school color: white, navy, red, hunter green.
