## **Policy Spotlight**

#### Why do we encourage parents and students to use carpool?

Yes, carpool is a convenient service we offer parents, but we offer this for a number of reasons. First, it is better for the child. When parents get out and walk their children to the classroom it delays the moment of separation and makes is more difficult to say goodbye for the day. Carpool also ensures that students arrive on time. It is distracting for the students working in the environment when friends arrive late. Imagine sitting at your desk and someone walking in your office every 5 minutes saying good morning, unpacking their briefcase, etc. Naturally, it would be difficult for you as an adult to concentrate and accomplish your tasks. This is even harder for a child that has a smaller attention span. We simply want to make things as easy as possible for you and your child.

### **Other Important Reminders**

#### Now Accepting Credit Cards:

We now accept Visa, Master Card, and Discover cards; however, we must charge a 2.5% processing fee. In order to use a credit card, we need the credit card number, expiration date, security code, cardholder's name and billing address, and a photo copy of the front and back of the credit card.

#### **Uniforms:**
